1. All the Teaching member to purpose Mentoring to provide a platform where experiences can be shared on a one to one informal basis maintaining confidentiality to establish a trusting relationship, thus providing support to student's at various stages in their course programme and career.
2. The mentorship committee assess the eligibility of prospective mentors and mentees on an ongoing basis.
3. Collect structured feedback from stakeholders to increase their interaction with the institution.
4. Four pillars of mentorship, trust, respect, expectation, and communication investing a few minutes to explicitly discuss the relationship expectation, and communication logistics will pay dividends in decreased frustration and improved satisfaction.



There are three types of mentoring.

1. Traditional one-on-one mentoring. A mentee and mentor are matched either through a program or on the own.

2. Distance Mentoring. A mentoring relationship in which the two parties (or group) are in different locations.

3. Group Mentoring. A single mentor is matched with a cohort of mentees.


### Characteristics of Excellent Mentors


- Good listener / sounding board

- Honest. Able to network and find resources.


